Aim® (carfentrazone)	14	Chickpeas, dry beans, faba beans, field peas, lentils, and soybeans	Broadleaf weeds	Can be tank-mixed with glyphosate
BlackHawk® (pyraflufen-ethyl + 2,4-D Ester)	14+4	Pulses and soybeans	Broadleaf weeds	Can be tank-mixed with Valtera™
CleanStart® (Carfentrazone + glyphosate)	14+9	Pulses and soybeans	Broadleaf and grassy weeds	
Distinct® (diflufenzopyr + dicamba)	4+19	Lentils, field peas, and soybeans (if applied prior to Oct 1)	Broadleaf weeds	Tank-mix with glyphosate is recommended
Express® SG (tribenuron methyl)	2	Dry beans, faba beans, field peas, lentils, and soybeans	Broadleaf weeds	Soil restrictions—follow label. Can be tank-mixed with glyphosate
Glyphosate (many brands)	9	Pulses and soybeans	Broadleaf and grassy weeds	
Heat® LQ (saflufenacil)	14	Chickpeas, field peas, lentils, and soybeans	Broadleaf weeds	Must be tank-mixed with glyphosate
Valtera™ (flumioxazin)	14	Chickpeas, field peas, lentils, and soybeans	Broadleaf weeds	Can be tank-mixed with glyphosate
Treflan™, Rival®, Bonanza® (trifluralin)	3	Dry beans, faba beans, field peas, lentils, and soybeans	Broadleaf weeds and grassy weeds	Must be soil incorporated; Incorporate within 24 hours of application
Edge™ Granular (ethafluralin)	3	Lentils and faba beans (fall only), dry beans (navy, kidney), field peas, and soybeans	Broadleaf weeds and grassy weeds	Must be soil incorporated; Do not apply to soils with <2% or >15% organic
